Building a safe and accountable environment

Part I: Enterprise-wide strategy and governance

A successful body camera deployment requires foundational planning and organizational alignment. This section outlines the critical strategic decisions and governance measures necessary to establish a clear policy framework and secure buy-in across all key departments.

Identify all key stakeholders (IT, Legal, Operations, HR, Labor Reps, Loss Prevention, etc).		
Secure early buy-in from critical departments, particularly IT and Legal		
Establish a clear body camera policy covering data capture, retention and access		
Ensure the policy fully addresses local, state and federal privacy regulations		
Discuss the full Motorola Solutions ecosystem and future capabilities		





Part II: System integration and infrastructure

This section focuses on the technical execution of your deployment. It covers necessary steps like validating your network’s capacity and integrating the cameras with existing IT infrastructure and any required third-party software, all beginning with a critical proof of concept.

Launch a proof of concept or pilot program for body cameras		
Confirm infrastructure compatibility (e.g., network bandwidth and device management systems)		
Map current security and safety measures for potential integrations and add ons		
Identify and plan for any necessary third party add-ons or integrations		





Part III: User training and operational protocol

This section focuses on the human element of deployment. It details the essential training necessary for staff to correctly operate the cameras, clearly addresses employee concerns regarding privacy and establishes robust protocols for handling video evidence post-incident.

RECOMMENDED ACTION	COMPLETED ✓ OR ✗	NOTES
Provide detailed training to all users on when and how to activate and operate the camera		
Emphasize that body cameras are a tool for employee support and transparency, not internal video security		
Proactively address staff concerns and misconceptions openly and supportively		
Define protocols for how recordings will be reviewed, flagged, categorized and securely stored		
Ensure incidents are tagged correctly for audit trails and legal disclosure		
Integrate video management protocols with existing incident reporting workflows		



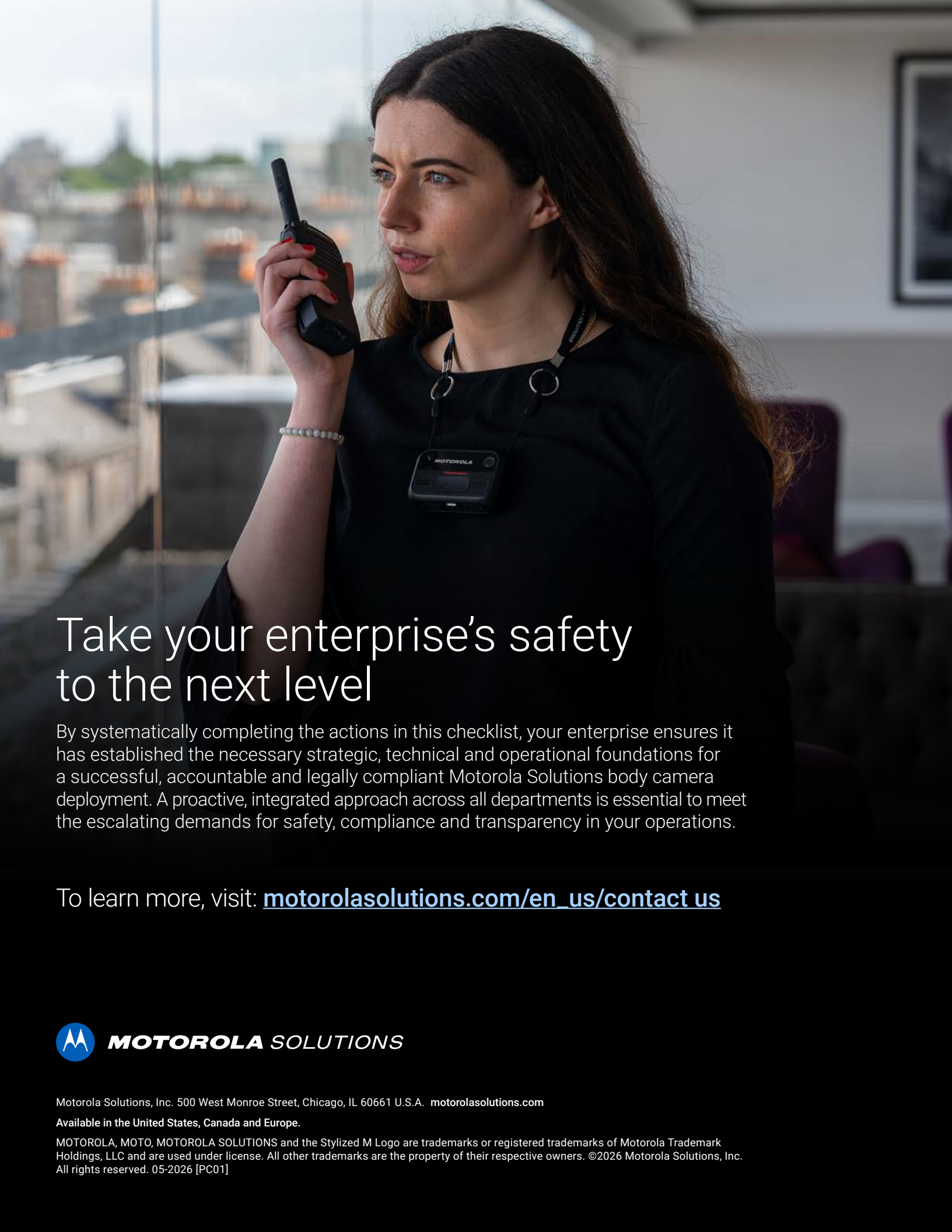


Part IV: External communication and trust

This section addresses how to build and maintain trust both internally and externally. It emphasizes the importance of clear, consistent messaging to all stakeholders about the camera's purpose and usage, mitigating public concerns and formalizing response processes for external inquiries.

Ensure clear, consistent communication about the rollout across all internal teams		
Clearly communicate to external parties (where applicable) how recordings will be used or reviewed		
Establish formal processes for handling external inquiries and concerns
